# How has the teaching of online safety changed?



- Sect 8 Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information such as your full name, email address, phone number, home address, photos or school name to people you are chatting with online.
- Can be dangerous. Only do so with your parents' or carers' permission and even then only when they can be present.
- CCCPTIOG: Accepting emails, IM messages, or opening files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems they may contain viruses or nasty messages!
  - RELIABLES Information you find on the internet may not be true, or someone online may be lying about who they are. Make sure you check information before you believe it.
- TELLS Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.



Avoid using your full name. Use your first name or create a nickname. Use an image or your Bitmoji as a profile picture.



Protect your reputation by avoiding unkindness when online.

### Privacy

Keep your passwords and personal details private.

5 P's for a positive Digital Footprint

#### Permission

Make sure you have permission to visit and use new apps. Also to share information online especially if it involves other people.

#### Positive

Make sure the information and photos you share are positive. Make sure your online activity makes you feel happy.
