Marcus Bousfield

Marcus studied Violin with Haroutune Bedelian at Chethams school of Music in Manchester and with Erika Klemperer at the Guildhall School of Music in London. He studied Guitar with Fred T. Baker at the Birmingham Conservatoire of Music.

He has worked as a freelance musician in both this country and abroad travelling as far afield as South Africa. He has been an instrumental teacher in York for over 20 years and plays with several ensembles and orchestras including the English National Orchestra and the National Symphony Orchestra. He has performed with renowned international artists, including soprano Angel Blue, tenor Alfie Boe and Classic FM's presenter and singer of the Snowman theme tune Aled Jones.

He has written and recorded string parts for groups including Ben Bruce (Asking Alexandria) and Shed Seven. His quartet performed for the Queen on her visit to York and has appeared on BBC Television and Radio. He conducts the York Youth String Orchestra and is the string tutor for York Youth Symphony Orchestra

His pupils have been members of the National Children's Orchestra of Great Britain, National Youth Orchestra of Great Britain and have gone on to study music at Chetham's School of Music and on to music college.

His previous pupils have gone on to become professional musicians in both teaching, performing and record producing.

Marcus holds an Associate of Trinity College London He is listed on the City of York Council's Approved Teachers Register and is a tutor for York Arts Education.

Learning To Play A Musical Instrument

Learning to play a musical instrument can be very beneficial to your child's learning and development. It can also be lots of fun and a great way for your child to make new friends.

Both the violin and the guitar are versatile instruments and, although challenging, can be very rewarding to play.

Instrumental Lessons

Lessons are provided for small groups or individuals. Groups of 3 or 4 are NOT available at secondary schools.

Lessons take place weekly at your child's school during school time and will last a maximum of thirty minutes.

A minimum of 33 lessons will be offered for each academic year, (i.e. approx. I I lessons per term).

Lessons continue from one year to the next unless notice to stop is given.

Loan instruments are available for £10 per term

Payment Of Fees

If you are wishing to cancel your lessons, half a terms written notice would be very much appreciated so that places can be allocated to pupils on the waiting list.
