Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to present you with the report following our recent Ofsted inspection that took place on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Inspectors agreed with the school's self-evaluation that it is **Good** in all areas.

Inspectors were very complementary about the warmth and care they observed in the school. As the report states children are proud to come to school, are respectful and treat each other with kindness. They recognised that the school has high ambitions for our children, and they achieve well. Also, that pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) can access the same curriculum as their peers and learn successfully alongside other pupils in lessons.

As you are aware the school is fully engaged in strengthening its curriculum. It was so encouraging that inspectors were able to see the results of that work, especially around history and physical education.

Inspectors have left us with some clear points for improvement around consistency of implementation. These align fully with the work we were doing and have planned to do over the next couple of years. They are fully embedded in the School Improvement Priorities which are regularly monitored by leaders, governors, and South York Multi Academy Trust.

As a school rooted in its community, we know how important relationships we build in school are and thank parents and carers for the continued support you give the school. Our pupils and staff all work incredibly hard, every single day, and this report reflects how effective the whole school community work together as a team.
